CLARIFICATION

Sub: Chargeable rates for treatment / investigations etc., for Private Hospitals as Approved Hospitals under Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 2013.

In exercise of powers vested in Rule 20 of Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 2013, vide order No. F.6(2)FD/Rules/2013 Pt.III dated 27-6-2015, the State Government has adopted the rates of CGHS Jaipur as may be amended from time to time shall be as maximum chargeable rates for various treatments, investigations and implants etc., which can be charged by the approved hospitals within the State for the treatment of Government servants appointed before 1-1-2004 and their family. It was decided that the maximum chargeable rates for NABH / NABL and Non-NABH/ Non-NABL hospitals shall be as per the CGHS rates for these categories respectively.

In this regard it is clarified that the approved hospital can charge CGHS - NABH when it has NABH accreditation. The hospital will not charge NABH rates during the period when the hospital is not accredited with NABH. Even if a private hospital is selected as Non NABH institution initially, and acquires NABH accreditation mid way, then from that day onwards would be eligible for CGHS-NABH rates as the case may be. Conversely if a private hospital is initially selected as NABH institution, but in midway the accreditation expires then from that day onwards would be entitled to charge as per CGHS rates for Non NABH institutions.

The same procedure shall be applicable for Raj Mediclaim Policy and above points will be incorporated in the agreement between SI&PF Department and concerned Hospital.
