Consequent upon promulgation of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 with effect from 01.09.2006, the Governor is pleased to order that the State Government employees may be allowed Dearness Allowance with the running pay bands and grade pays from the dates mentioned below at the following rates: -


Date from which Payable	Rate of Dearness Allowance per mensem
From 01.01.2007	6%
From 01.07.2007	9%
From 01.01.2008	12%
From 01.07.2008	16%

2. The payment of Dearness Allowance under this order from the dates 01.01.2007, 01.07.2007 and 01.01.2008 indicated above shall be made after adjusting the amount of Dearness Allowance already paid from time to time under existing orders.

3. The term 'Pay' for the purpose of calculation of Dearness Allowance shall be the Basic Pay i.e. total of pay in running pay band and grade pay drawn and shall not include any other type(s) of pay like Special Pay or Personal Pay, etc.

4. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fraction of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

"5. Rate of House Rent Allowance and Classification of Cities/Towns:

- (1) The House Rent Allowance to a Government servant if admissible under these rules shall be granted within the corporation/municipal/urban agglomeration limits of places mentioned in sub-rule (2) and at unclassified places at the rates indicated below: -

Classification of Cities/Towns	Rates of House Rent Allowance (per month)
Y (Population criteria 50 - 5 Lakhs) (Earlier classified as 'A', 'B-1' and 'B-2')	20% of the Basic Pay i.e. total of Pay in running pay band and grade pay
Z (Population criteria below 5 Lakhs) (Earlier classified as 'C' and unclassified)	10% of the Basic Pay i.e. total of Pay in running pay band and grade pay

- (2) The classification of cities/towns for the purpose of grant of House Rent Allowance under sub-rule (1) shall be as under: -

Cities Classified as 'Y'	Cities Classified as 'Z'
1. Bikaner, 2. Jaipur, 3. Jodhpur (UA), 4. Kota (UA)	Remaining Cities / Towns and other places."

In the said rules - the existing Rule 3 shall be substituted by the following, namely -

"3. **Rate of Compensatory (City) Allowance** : The Compensatory (City) Allowance to Government servants referred to in sub-rule (1) of Rule 1, shall be granted at the following rates: -

Note: 1. Government servants who are entitled to free boarding (or messing allowance) and free lodging as a condition of their appointment shall be entitled to receive the allowance @ 50% of the rates prescribed under this rule.

2. For the purpose of 'Note 1' Police personnel living in barracks of Police Lines/Police Stations in Ajmer, Bikaner, Jaipur, Jodhpur and Kota City shall not be considered to be availing of the facility of free lodging and therefore, such Police personnel shall be entitled to the allowance at full rates.

3. Government servants who are availing of only one facility of free boarding (messing allowance) or lodging shall be entitled to receive the allowance at full rates."

Sub: Amendment in the Rajasthan Travelling Allowance Rules.

The Governor has been pleased to order that the following amendments shall be made in the Rajasthan Travelling Allowance Rules, 1971, namely: -

- (1) The existing Rule 4 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -
"4. For the purpose of calculating Travelling Allowance including Daily Allowance, Government servants are divided into five categories, as under: -

Categories	Class of Government servants based on 'Basic Pay' i.e. total of pay in Running Pay Band and Grade Pay
Category 'A'	Government servants drawing basic pay of Rs. 37,000/- per month or above.
Category 'B'	Government servants drawing basic pay of Rs.19,000/- and above but below Rs.37,000/- per month.
Category 'C'	Government servants drawing basic pay of Rs.15,000/- and above but below Rs.19,000/- per month.
Category 'D'	Government servants drawing basic pay of Rs.10,000/- and above but below Rs.15,000/- per month.
Category 'E'	Government servants drawing basic pay below Rs.10,000/- per month."

- (2) In Col. No. 1 of Appendix - III - "Mileage Allowance for Travel by Air" - the existing words and figures "Rs.12000/-", "Rs.16400/-" and "Rs.26000/-" wherever occurring shall be substituted by the words and figures "Rs.27000/-", "Rs.37000/-" and "Rs.80000/-", respectively.
- (3) The existing scale "12000-16500" appearing in Col. No. 5 against Serial Number 4 of the Schedule of Delegation of Powers shall be substituted by "Grade Pay of Rs.7600/-".

Sub. : - Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1970.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor hereby makes the following rules to amend further the existing Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 1970, namely: -

1. (i) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) (Amendment) Rules, 2008.
- (ii) They shall come into force with effect from 01.09.2008.
2. (i) For the existing clause (xiii) of sub-rule (3) of Rule 2, shall be substituted by the following, namely: -
"(xiii) **"Pay"** for the purpose of these rules, means total of pay in running pay band and grade pay drawn."

- (ii) For the existing sub-clause (i) of clause (a) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 4, shall be substituted by the following, namely: -

"(i) Accommodation in the Government Hospital as classified below, shall be provided free of charge, subject to availability: -

Pay Slab	Class of Accommodation
(a) Rs.25,000/- or above	Deluxe or Cottage Ward
(b) Rs.14,000/- or above but below Rs.25,000/-	Cottage Ward
(c) Below Rs.14,000/- but above Rs.6,600/-	Rental Ward of the lowest category."

- (iii) In clause (c) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 4, the existing words and figures "Rs.3600/- per month" shall be substituted by the words and figures "Rs.9000/- per month".

- (iv) The existing sub-rule (4) of Rule 8 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -

"(4) A Government servant shall present a consolidated claim for reimbursement of medical expenses not earlier than once in a month in respect of all the members of his family including himself/ herself after the treatment is over. In cases where


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treatment continues over a long period, a part claim for reimbursement of medical expenses may be presented by the Government servants as follows: -

- (v) In clause (v) of sub-rule (2) of Rule 10, the existing words and figures "Rs.6700/- per month" shall be substituted by the words and figures "Rs.16500/- per month".
- (vi) In clause (a) of sub-rule (4) of Rule 10, the existing words and figures "Rs.6700/- per month" shall be substituted by the words and figures "Rs.16500/- per month".

2. The amount of Non-Practising Allowance / Non-Clinical Allowance shall be treated as "Pay" for the purpose of admissibility of Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance and City Compensatory Allowance.

3. The grant of Non-Clinical and Non-Practising Allowance is subject to the condition that the Officer does not undertake any private practice and does not accept any fee as Authorised Medical Attendant of Government servants. Every Government Servant in receipt of Non-Clinical/ Non-Practising Allowance shall submit every month the following certificate to his Head of Office / Head of Department who draws his monthly pay and allowances on establishment pay bills for attaching the same with the pay bill.

"It is certified that no private practice was undertaken by me and no professional fee was received during the month of 200..... for which Non-Practising / Non-Clinical Allowance is admissible to me.

4. In case it is discovered that an officer in receipt of Non-Clinical or Non-Practising Allowance has indulged in private practice and received fee therefore he shall render himself liable to disciplinary action under the Rajasthan Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1958 as amended from time to time, and the entire amount of Non-Clinical / Non-Practising Allowance paid to him to date shall be recoverable from him.

5. The payment of incentive money received by an officer from the Family Planning Organisation will not be regarded as fee for private practice.

6. Non-accrual of Arrears : - No arrear shall accrue for the period from 01.09.2006 to 31.12.2006 (both days inclusive).





Sub.: - Amendment in the Rajasthan Service Rules, 1951.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the Governor hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Service Rules, 1951, namely: -

1. These rules may be called the Rajasthan Service (Amendment) Rules, 2008.
2. They shall come into force with effect from 01.01.2007.
3. In the said rules -
 - (i) in the 'Clarification' appearing below Rule 35, the existing words and figures "3% of the presumptive pay" and "6% of the presumptive pay", wherever occurring shall be substituted by the words and figures "1.5% of the presumptive pay i.e. sum of basic pay in the running pay band and grade pay" and "3% of the presumptive pay i.e. sum of basic pay in the running pay band and grade pay" respectively.
 - (ii) in the 'Note' under 'Clarification' appearing below Rule 35, the existing words and figures "3% of his own pay" and "6% of his own pay" shall be substituted by the words and figures "1.5% of his own basic pay i.e. sum of pay in the running pay band and grade pay" and "3% of his own basic pay i.e. sum of pay in the running pay band and grade pay" respectively.
 - (iii) the existing clause (ii) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 50 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -
 - "(ii) for the other post he draws such reasonable pay but in no case exceeding 3% of the presumptive pay i.e. sum of basic pay in the running pay band and grade pay of the post as the Government may fix; and"
 - (iv) in sub-rule (2) of Rule 97, the existing words and figures "Rs.9500/-" shall be substituted by the words and figures "Rs.23000/-".
 - (v) in Rule 105, the existing words and figures "Rs.5000/-" shall be substituted by the words and figures "Rs.12000/-".

(vi) in 'Government of Rajasthan's Decision' appearing below Rule 144-A -

(a) the existing sub-para (i) of para 3 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -

"(i) The Deputation (Duty) Allowance shall be @2.5% of basic pay i.e. sum of pay in the running pay band and grade pay of the employee subject to a maximum of Rs.600/- per month."

(b) the existing item (ii) of 'Exception' appearing in 'Government of Rajasthan's Decision' shall be substituted by the following, namely: -

"(ii) With a view to ensuring that a Government servant on deputation does not get abnormal increase in the pay because of the option exercised as at clause (i) above, it has been decided that where minimum of the basic pay i.e. sum of pay in running pay band and grade pay of the deputation post is substantially in excess of the deputationist's basic pay i.e. sum of pay in running pay band and grade pay plus deputation (duty) allowance @ 2.5%, the appointing authority may restrict the pay of the deputationist even below the minimum of the deputation post under Rule 36 of Rajasthan Service Rules. In such a case, the pay allowed under Rule 36 of Rajasthan Service Rules should not exceed by 3.5% of basic pay i.e. sum of pay in running pay band and grade pay of the deputationist."

(vii) in 'Appendix - IX' of the said rules -

(a) in column 5 against serial number 7, the existing words and figures "the maximum pay whereof does not exceed Rs.13500/-" shall be substituted by the words and figures "the grade pay whereof does not exceed Rs.5400/-".

(b) the existing serial number 14 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of Constitution and Rule 21 of Rajasthan Service Rules, 1951, the Governor hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Government Servants' General Provident Fund Rules, 1997, namely: -

1. These rules may be called the Rajasthan Government Servants' General Provident Fund (Amendment) Rules, 2008.
2. They shall come into force with effect from 01.09.2008.
3. (a) the existing sub-rule (ix) of Rule 2 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -
"(ix) 'Pay' means total of pay in Running Pay Band and Grade Pay thereon."
- (b) the existing clause (i) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 11 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -
"(i) Monthly deposit depending upon the total of pay in Running Pay Band and Grade Pay thereon of the subscriber at the rates prescribed below: -

Total of Pay in Running Pay Band and Grade Pay	Rate of Deduction (in rupees)
Upto Rs.9000/-	400.00
Rs.9001/- to Rs.11000/-	500.00
Rs.11001/- to Rs.15000/-	900.00

Subject : Amendment in the Rajasthan Government Servants' Insurance Rules, 1998.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution and Rule 21 of the Rajasthan Service Rules, 1951, the Governor hereby makes the following rules to amend further the Rajasthan Government Servants' Insurance Rules, 1998, namely: -

1. (i) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Government Servants' Insurance (Amendment) Rules, 2008.
(ii) These rules shall come into force with effect from 01.04.2009.
2. The existing clause (i) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 11 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -

"(i) The monthly premium payable by the insured under the insurance scheme shall be as specified: -

S. No.	Pay Slab based on total of Running Pay Band and Grade Pay	Rate of Monthly Premium (Rs.)
(a)	Rs.6050/- to Rs.8500/-	180/-
(b)	Rs.8501/- to Rs.11000/-	240/-
(c)	Rs.11001/- to Rs.18000/-	480/-
(d)	Rs.18001/- to Rs.28000/-	720/-
(e)	Above Rs.28000/-	1200/-

Explanation: -

- (i) The assured official is not required to fill in the declaration for further assurance in relaxation of provision of clause (ii) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 11.
 - (ii) The new slab rates would be applicable to salaries of March paid in April, 2009."
3. The existing sub-rule (2) of Rule 11 shall be substituted by the following, namely: -
"(2) An insured person may at his option, contribute premium of either of the rates specified in the next two slabs over the premium rate applicable to him under clause (i) of sub-rule (1) of Rule 11 provided that an insured person paying normal premium at the rate of Rs.720/- per month or Rs.1200/- per month may contribute either Rs.1200/- per month or Rs.1500/- per month."

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Civil Services (Determination and Recovery of Rent of Residential Accommodation) Rules, 1958, namely: -

1. (i) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Civil Services (Determination and Recovery of Rent of Residential Accommodation) (Amendment) Rules, 2008.
 - (ii) These rules shall be deemed to have come into force with effect from 01.01.2007.
2. For the existing sub-rule (2) of Rule 18 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Determination and Recovery of Rent of Residential Accommodation) Rules, 1958, the following shall be substituted, namely: -

"(2)(a) Unless otherwise expressly provided in these rules, the Government servants who draw pay under the Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008, shall pay monthly rent according to the following rates: -

Sr. No.	Pay Slab based on Basic Pay i.e. total of Pay in Running Pay Band and Grade Pay	Rate of Rent
1.	Below Rs.13000/- per month.	0.75% of the pay
2.	Rs.13000 and above but below Rs.19000/- per month.	1.5% of the pay
3.	Rs.19000 per month and above.	2% of the pay

- (b) The Officers of All India Services and Central Government employees on deputation drawing pay in the revised pay scales effective from 01.01.2006 shall pay monthly rent according to the rates applicable to the State Government servants who draw pay under the Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008.

Provided that Government servants residing in the category of accommodation lower than the one to which they are entitled to shall not be required to pay rent more than the maximum amount of rent payable by an employee who is entitled to that lower category of accommodation."
