NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Rajasthan Excise Act, 1950 (Act No. II of 1950), the State Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Excise (Grant of Hotel Bar/Club Bar Licences) Rules, 1973 and orders with reference to the proviso to sub-section (3) of the said section that previous publication of these amendment rules is dispensed with as the State Government considers that they should be brought into force at once.

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Excise (Grant of Hotel Bar/Club Bar Licences) (Amendment) Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of rule 3.- The existing sub-rule (3) of rule 3 of the Rajasthan Excise (Grant of Hotel Bar/Club Bar Licences) Rules, 1973, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"(3) Every application for a Hotel Bar/Club Bar licence shall be properly signed and shall be accompanied by the 10% of the following amount of initial licence fees:-

The licensee of Hotel Bar/Club Bar shall deposit the remaining 90% of initial licence fee within seven working days from the date of issue of Hotel Bar/Club Bar Licence.

Explanation: The counting of rooms for Heritage Hotel category includes the number of newly constructed rooms and old traditional rooms

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3. Insertion of new rule 3-C.- After the existing rule 3-B and before rule 4 of the said rules, following new rule shall be inserted, namely:-

“3-C. Swiss Tents Bar Licence.- Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules Hotel Bar Licence may also be granted by the Excise Commissioner in Form C to any establishment having at least ten units of swiss tents like temporary structure having the permission of the local body or having licence granted by the competent authority under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 and having GSTN registration, for the period of one year on payment of 75% of fee specified under rule 3 of these rules. The licence may also be granted for the period of not less than six months or upto the end of the financial year whichever is earlier on payment of 50% of fee specified under rule 3 of these rules. The licence granted under this rule may be extended for remaining period of the financial year on payment of 25% of fee specified in rule 3 in these rules.”

4. Amendment of rule 7-A.- In sub-rule (1) of rule 7-A of the said rules,-

- (i) for the existing punctuation mark “.” appearing at the end, the punctuation mark “:” shall be substituted; and
- (ii) at the end, the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

“Provided that a licence for Hotel Bar may also be granted or renewed, as the case may be, for a period of five consecutive financial years on the payment of amount equivalent to the four times of the fee applicable for the First year of that period as specified in sub-rule (3) of rule 3 of these rules.”
