NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 41 of the Rajasthan Excise Act, 1950 (Act No. II of 1950), the State Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Excise Rules, 1956 and orders with reference to the proviso to sub-section (3) of the said section that the previous publication of these amendment rules is dispensed with as the State Government considers that they should be brought into force at once, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Excise (Amendment) Rules, 2023.

(2) They shall come into force at once.

2. Amendment of rule 49.- In sub-rule (6) of rule 49 of the Rajasthan Excise Rules, 1956, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, for the existing expression "in available premises of the RTDC" shall be deleted.

3. Amendment of rule 53-A.- In rule 53-A of the said rules, for the existing expression "Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP)", the expression "Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF)" shall be substituted.

4. Substitution of rule 54.- The existing rule 54 of the said rules shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"54. Occasional licence.- In respect of the entertainments of temporary nature, occasional licence may be granted for a period not exceeding 45 days and for such hours and on such terms and conditions as may be specified in the licence for,-

- (a) consumption of foreign liquor at Private residence on payment of fee Rs. 2000/- per day (when there is no sale and liquor is served);
- (b) sale of foreign liquor on payment of fee Rs. 12000/- per day; and
- (c) consumption of foreign liquor in premises having Hotel/Club bar licence under the Rajasthan Excise (Grant of Hotel Bar/Club Bar Licences) Rules, 1973, if the liquor is procured and served by the organiser at his own level, on payment of fee Rs. 12000/- per day:

Provided that a person having occasional licence can lift draught beer from a brewery notwithstanding the provisions of rule 47 of these rules.

Provided further that no occasional licence for commercial places shall be granted other than the commercial places registered by the District Excise Officer on payment of registration fee Rs. 20000/- per year.

5. Amendment of rule 68.- In table appearing below rule 68 of the said rules,-

- (i) the existing serial number (6-A) and entries thereto shall be deleted; and
- (ii) the existing serial number (6-B) and entries thereto shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

of,-

(a)	Distillery/Brewery	5,00,000/-
(b)	Bottling Plant	2,50,000/-
(c)	Heritage Manufactory	1,25,000/-
(d)	Winery	45,000/-"

6. Amendment of rule 69.- In rule 69 of the said rules,-

(i) in sub-rule (1), under the head Wholesale licence, the existing clause (A) and entries thereto shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"(A) For a brand of imported foreign liquor having basic price including import fee and any other fee payable per carton of Quarts, Pints, Nips or other packing size as declared by supplier/manufacturers, -	Licence fees
(a) upto Rs. 3100	75% ad-valorem
(b) above Rs. 3100 but upto Rs. 6000	70% ad-valorem (minimum Rs. 2325)
(c) above Rs. 6000 but upto Rs. 8000	55% ad-valorem (minimum Rs. 4200)
(d) above Rs. 8000 but upto Rs. 50000	45% ad-valorem (minimum Rs. 4400)
(e) above Rs. 50000	40% ad-valorem (minimum Rs. 22500)

(ii) in sub-rule (2), the existing proviso to clause (a) shall be substituted by the following ,namely:-

"Provided that following discount shall be allowed to manufacturing units on production of beer in excess of average production of last three years or actual production of the year 2022-23, whichever is higher, for beer supplied to the Rajasthan State Beverages Corporation Limited for sale in Rajasthan:-

S. No.	Production	Discount in bottling fee (per bulk litre)
1.	Upto 115%	Nil
2.	above 115% and upto 125%	Rs. 1.00/-
3	above 125%	RS. 2.00/-

Explanation: The above discount shall be calculated for each slab separately i.e. if production is 130% discount shall be, for upto 115% - nil, for above 115% to 125% - Rs 1.00 per bulk litre and for above 125% to 130% - Rs 2.00 per bulk litre.";

(iii) in table of sub-rule (3),-

(a) in column number 7 against serial number 3, for the existing expression "25000", the expression "50000" shall be substituted;

- (b) in column number 4 against serial number 4, for the existing expression "25000", the expression "10000" shall be substituted; and
- (c) after the existing serial number 5 and entries thereto, the following new serial number 6 and entries thereto shall be added, namely:-
- "6. Rajasthan Heritage Liquor 50000 10000 - - 10000"; and
- (iv) in sub-rule (5), for the existing "Indo-Tibetan Border Police (ITBP)", the expression "Central Armed Police Forces (CAPF)" shall be substituted.
