**G.S.R.18** .-In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 6 of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Act, 2012 (Act No. 21 of 2012) read with rule 33 of the Rajasthan Transparency in Public Procurement Rules, 2013, the State Government, in view of 'Ease of Doing Business', to ensure transparency and competition in public procurement as well as working towards 'Aatmanirbhar Bharat' and to ensure the best use of government fund in public interest, necessary for the promotion of domestic industry and for furtherance of socio-economic policy of the State Government, hereby notifies to the procuring entity to accord preference to goods and services manufactured in country (Make in India)in public procurement, in the following manner, namely :-

1. For the purpose of this notification,-
  - (a) "**Class 1 Local Supplier**" means a supplier or service provider, whose goods, services offered for procurement, has local content equal to or more than 50% ;
  - (b) "**Local content**" means the amount of value added in India which unless otherwise prescribed by the Nodal Department, shall be the total value of item procured (excluding net domestic indirect taxes) minus the value of imported content in the item (including all customs duties) as a proportion of total value, in percent;
  - (c) "**Non-Class 1 supplier**" means a supplier or service provider, whose goods or services offered for procurement, has local content less than 50%;
  - (d) "**Non-MSE Class-I local supplier**" means a supplier or service provider, whose goods or services offered for procurement, has local content equal to or more than 50% and not belong to MSE category;and

(e) **“Margin of Purchase Preference”** - the margin of purchase preference shall be 20%.

2. During the procurement process, for items not included in Schedule of Notification No. F.1(8)FD/GF&AR/ 2011 dated 19.11.2015, as amended from time to time, in case of the following category of bidders being declared as L-1, the distribution of subject matter of procurement shall be as follows :

L-1	Distribution
MSEs from Rajasthan	100% quantity order to be placed to the L-1 bidder subject to provisions of this Notification.
Class-I Local Supplier from outside Rajasthan	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 20% quantity order to be placed to the original lowest bidder enterprise.</li> <li>• For remaining 80% quantity, purchase preference shall be given to MSEs of Rajasthan as per provisions mentioned below.</li> </ul>

3. Purchase preference to eligible bidders shall be given in the following manner, subject to fulfillment of all required specifications and conditions of the bid :-
- opportunity shall be given to the eligible bidders to supply offered quantity. Within the offered quantity for procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises of Rajasthan, 4% of this quantity shall be earmarked for procurement from Micro and Small Enterprises of Rajasthan owned by member of Scheduled Caste or Scheduled Tribe.
  - to exercise this option of Purchase Preference, a counter offer would be given to the eligible bidder, which has quoted the minimum rate among the eligible bidders, to match the overall lowest (L-1) rate received.
  - in case, the lowest eligible bidders does not agree to the counter offer as per sub clause (ii) above, or does not have the capacity to provide the entire bid

quantity, the same counter offer shall be made to the next lowest bidder among the eligible bidders, in that order till the quantity to be supplied is met.

- (iv) if the subject matter of procurement is non-divisible in nature, the contract shall be awarded to the original lowest bidder.
