NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) Rules, 2013, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Civil Services (Medical Attendance) (Amendment) Rules, 2024.

(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. Amendment of rule 4.- In rule 4 of the Rajasthan Civil Service (Medical Attendance) Rules, 2013, hereinafter referred to as the said rules, the existing sub-rule (1) shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"(1) There shall be a Standing Committee to be known as Health Benefit Empowered Committee, consisting of,-

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| (i) Additional Chief Secretary / Principal Secretary,
Finance Department, Government of Rajasthan | Chairman |
| (ii) Pr. Secretary/ Secretary, Medical Education Department,
Government of Rajasthan | Member |
| (iii) Secretary, Finance (Budget) Department,
Government of Rajasthan | Member |
| (iv) Principal, S.M.S. Medical College, Jaipur | Member |
| (v) Superintendent, S.M.S. Hospital, Jaipur | Member |
| (vi) Director, Medical & Health Services, Rajasthan | Member |
| (vii) Joint / Deputy Secretary Finance Department
(Rules Division), Government of Rajasthan | Member Secretary |

3. Substitution of rule 17.- The existing rule 17 of the said rules shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"17. Reimbursement of medical expenses from two sources.- (1) A Government servant, who is availing medical facility under the Rajasthan Government Health Scheme (RGHS), may be allowed to claim reimbursement from both the sources i.e. insurance company and Rajasthan Government Health Scheme (RGHS). The claims in such cases shall be preferred as per procedure stated below:

- (i) The beneficiary shall make the claim first to the insurance company and the residual claim if any, under the RGHS.
- (ii) Original vouchers/bills would be submitted to such insurance company along with claims. The company shall retain such originals and issue certified copies clearly indicating amount met out or reimbursed on each bill/voucher in ink along with stamp and also issue certificate of total amount met out or reimbursed by it.
- (iii) The beneficiary would then prefer his/her residual medical reimbursement claim through the RGHS portal alongwith relevant documents and his/her claim should be decided as per provisions under these rules.

(2) Reimbursement under the RGHS shall be limited to the amount admissible as per provisions of these rules absolutely and shall be over and above the amount met out by the insurance company. The reimbursement from both sources should not exceed total expenditure incurred by the beneficiary on the treatment."
