
In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996, namely :-

1. Short Title and Commencement. - (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) (Third Amendment) Rules, 2015.
(2) They shall come into force with immediate effect.

2. Substitution of Rule 164 A. - The existing rule 164 A of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996 shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

"164A. Reappointment on consolidated remuneration.- Notwithstanding anything contained in rule 149 to 164, in cases where a post is lying vacant in any service and regular recruitment to the post shall take time and the post cannot be retained vacant in public interest, the retired Government servant who has not completed the age of 65 years may be reemployed by the concerned Administrative Department in the first instance for one year, if the post still remains vacant after expiry of one year, then the Administrative Department, after recording reasons for non filling of post, may extend the period of re-employment by another one year. Beyond two years re-employment shall not be extended without the prior concurrence of Department of Personnel and Finance Department. Such re-employment shall be for the period till regularly selected persons are made available for appointment or till the reemployed person attains the age of 65 years, whichever is earlier. Such reemployed person shall be allowed consolidated remuneration as decided by the Government in Department of Personnel, from time to time. During the period of reemployment only casual leave shall be admissible and any other kind of leave with remuneration shall not be admissible. The Administrative Department before re-employment shall ensure that the post is clearly lying vacant and such reemployment shall not affect adversely the promotion opportunity of any employee and the person to be reemployed has satisfactory service record."
