**Sub : Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 - Clarification
in regard to Rule 15 of these rules.**

As per provisions contained in Rule 15 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 in case a Government Servant reaches the maximum of the running pay band, shall be placed in the next higher running pay band after one year of reaching such a maximum. At the time of placement in the higher pay band, benefit of one increment will be provided. Thereafter, he will continue to move in the higher pay band till his pay in the running pay band reaches the maximum of PB-4, after which no further increments will be granted. For example if a Government servant who reaches at the maximum of the running pay band on 01.07.2009 he gets annual increment after completion of service of one year on 01.07.2010 in the next higher running pay band.

It has been brought to the notice of the Government that in cases where Government servants reached at the maximum of their running pay band and are granted Assured Career Progression or promoted to the next higher post before completion of one year after reaching such a maximum do not get benefit of pay fixation of one increment equal to 3% of the sum of the pay in the running pay band and grade pay.

To resolve this problem, the matter has been considered and the Governor is pleased to order that the Government servants who reached at the maximum of their running pay band and are granted Assured Career Progression or promoted to the next higher post before completion of one year after reaching such a maximum, such Government servants shall be placed in the next higher running pay band from the date they have been granted Assured Career Progression or promoted to the next higher post and benefit of increase of 3% of sum of pay in the RPB and grade pay shall be admissible to them in the next higher running pay band. Those who are promoted after availing ACP will not be entitled to 3% fixation benefit and they will be entitled to only difference of grade pay.


