ORDER

No. F. 12 (32) FD/Tax/2024-Pt-III- 08

Jaipur, Dated: 17.07.2026

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 7.3.1 of the Rajasthan Investment Promotion Scheme-2024 (hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme"), the State Government being of the opinion that it is expedient in the public interest so to do, hereby modifies the Scheme by making the following amendments, with immediate effect, namely:-

AMENDMENTS

1. Amendment in Sub-Section 3.1.1.3 –

- **After the first sub-bullet point of second bullet point** of sub-section 3.1.1.3, the following expression shall be added, namely:-

Provided that, in case of units engaged in manufacturing of Multilayer PCBs, supply chain of sub-assemblies and bare components, and capital goods used in electronics manufacturing, including sub-assemblies and components; as defined under or in relation to the Electronics Components Manufacturing Scheme (ECMS) of the Government of India, the minimum eligible investment required to avail incentives under this package shall be INR 15 crore (Investments between INR 15-50 crores to be treated under large category).

2. Amendment in Sub-Section 6.1 –

- **After The expression** "and INR 25 crores for Service Enterprises, with a maximum of three phases allowed" mentioned in the first bullet point of sub-section 6.1, the following expression shall be added, namely:-

However, in case of sectors and sub-sectors as defined under the Electronics Components Manufacturing Scheme, 2025 of the Government of India, an investment may be undertaken in a maximum of five phases. Provided that each such phase shall meet the minimum investment threshold prescribed for the relevant sub-sector under the said Government of India scheme, or INR 15 crores, whichever is higher.

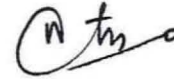


3. Amendment in Sub-Section 4.3.1-

- In the table for sub-section 4.3.1 Add-On Skilling & Training Incentives in sub-sections 4.3 Capability Development, following new serial no. 1A shall be added, namely:-

SN	Focus Category	Skilling & Training Incentives
1A	Manufacturing Enterprises related to sectors and sub-sectors as defined under the Electronics Components Manufacturing Scheme, 2025 of the Government of India.	Enterprises shall be eligible for reimbursement of 50% of the total cost of employee training, up to a maximum of INR 6,000 /- per worker per month, for women and handicapped workers for a maximum of 6 months, as a one-time incentive.

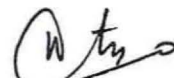
